Writer and director Rory Alexander Stewart received the BAFTA New Talent Writer Award in 2013 for his debut short film LIAR. The following year, his follow up, the no-budget improvised short GOOD GIRL went on to win The Skinny/Innis & Gunn short film award. With the prize money from GOOD GIRL, Rory made his next short film MISERY GUTS, which was nominated for the Channel 4 Award for



Innovation in Storytelling. His short film IN THE GRASS, about a detective suffering from a crisis in confidence, played in competition at Clermont-Ferrand after premiering at Warsaw International Film Festival 2016.

Rory's latest short film WILD HORSES premiered at the 70th Cannes Film Festival in the Cinéfondation Selection. He his now in development on his debut feature film with Escape Plan Productions.
