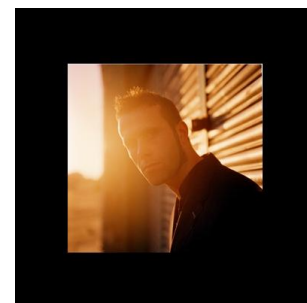


Martin Smith
