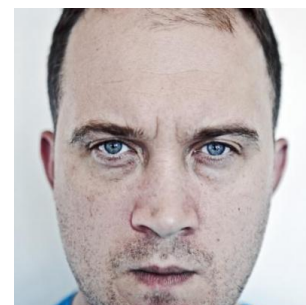


Chris Thorpe
