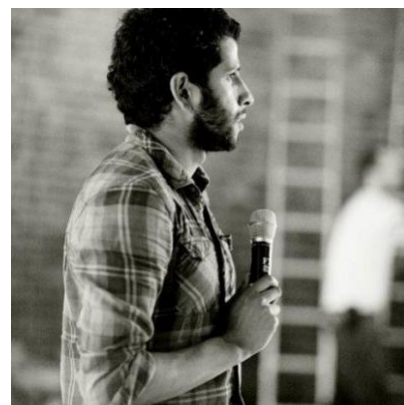


Prasanna Puwanarajah
