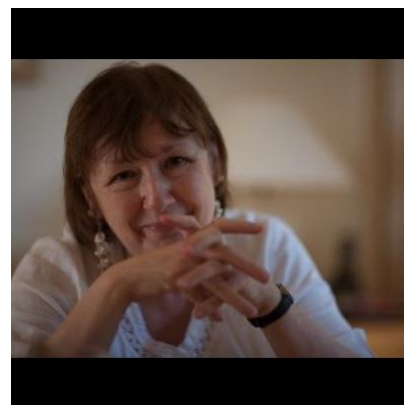


Marilyn Imrie
