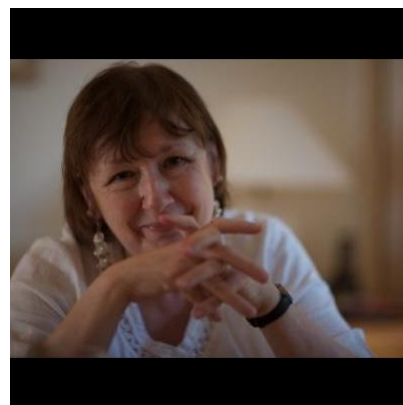


## Marilyn Imrie (Estate)
