Frances Poet is a Glasgow based writer. She is currently working on a number of stage plays including an original musical commission for Citizens Theatre SMALL ACTS OF LOVE; STRIKIN` LASSIES for NTS; MOTHER for Birds of Paradise Theatre Company and a play for PACE Theatre titled THERE IS NO ROOM IN OUR BATHROOM FOR LEWIS CAPALDI. Frances has written on series one and series two of



Black Camel Media's drama ANNIKA, which stars Nicola Walker. She also adapted her stage play ADAM for the Scottish BAFTA winning screen version aired on the BBC. She is currently writing the third series of Radio 4 drama THIS THING OF DARKNESS.

Other stage plays include MAGGIE MAY (Leeds Playhouse 2022, finalist of the Susan Smith Blackburn Prize 2020/2021), STILL (Traverse Theatre 2021), FIBRES (Citizens Theatre/Stella Quines Production, Scottish Tour 2019), GUT (Writers Guild Best Play Award winner, UK Theatre Best Play Award nominated and Bruntwood Prize For Playwriting Shortlisted, Traverse Theatre & Tron Theatre 2018 and in a French translation as MADRA, Théâtre La Licorne, Montréal 2019) and the multi-award winning ADAM (Scottish and UK tours 2017/18 and NYU Skirball Centre 2019).

Frances has also completed a number of classic adaptations including THE MACBETHS (Citizens Theatre/Scottish Tour 2017/18), WHAT PUT THE BLOOD (Abbey Theatre, Dublin 2017 and previously as ANDROMAQUE Scottish Tour 2015), DANCE OF DEATH (Citizens Theatre 2016) and THE MISANTHROPE (Oran Mòr 2014). Her play CRUSADERS is part of NT Connections 2020.

Radio work includes ALT DELETE (BBC Radio 3 October 2019), GUT (BBC Radio 4 October 2019) and THE DISAPPOINTED (BBC Radio Scotland 2015).

Screen work includes several episodes of River City and several short films that have played at National and International festivals.
