During her time at Royal Welsh, Harriet worked with director Debbie Hannan for the New Season at the Gate Theatre. Sadly the run was cut short after its opening night by COVID. Nevertheless, Harriet later returned to Cardiff in December 2020 to play Beauty/Amiga in Suzan Lori-Parks' play In the Blood directed by Lekan Lewal at the Sherman Theatre.

Originally from New Zealand and Australia, Harriet ventured to London in 2017 to pursue her studies in acting. Outside of acting, Harriet is writing a show for The Hope Theatre in Islington, and developing a project for television.
