Chelsea is an award-winning director, working in theatre and on screen. In 2017 she won the RTST Sir Peter Hall Award and toured her critically acclaimed production of A Streetcar Named Desire around the UK. She has twice been a finalist for the JMK Directors Award, winning the runner up prize in 2016; has twice been nominated for an Off West End Best Director Award; and twice nominated for a UK Theatre Award. In 2016 she was a director on the Old Vic 12. She is a reader for the Bruntwood Award and Susan Smith Blackburn Prize. Chelsea has just finished post-production on her short film LATCH. Her first short film GOBBLE written by Anoushka Warden premiered at Funny Life Film Festival and will be screened at British Shorts Film Festival in Berlin.
