Pai Hsien-Yung is an internationally acclaimed author and the founder of *Modern Literature* magazine. He is generally considered among the greatest living stylists of Chinese fiction and prose. His publications include the collections of short stories *Lonely Seventeen*, *Taipei People*, and *The New Yorker*; the collection of prose writing *Suddenly the Past*; and the novel *Crystal Boys*. Pai became a professor of Chinese literature at the University of California, Santa Barbara in 1965, and retired in 1994.
