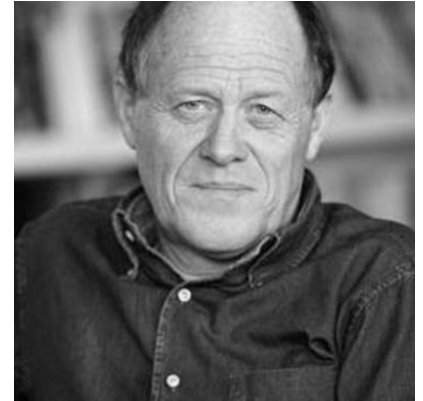


James Le Fanu
