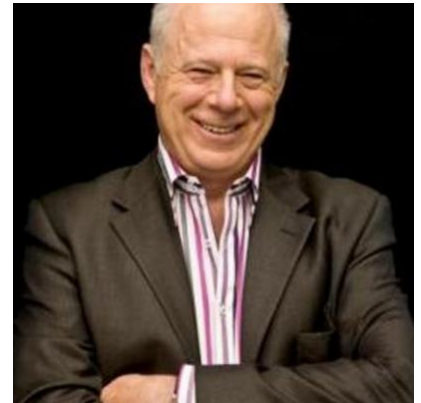


## Matthew Fort
